



## Life Group Questions

Part 1: Eye on the Prize  
1 Corinthians 9:24-27

- 1). Ice Breaker – In your family, who is the most competitive person? What do they do to make you think that?
  
- 2). Have you ever avoided something in life because you weren't sure you could win or you were afraid to lose? Share your story.
  
- 3). In the past, how have you defined winning in life? Have you ever adopted someone else's win (a parent, teacher, coach, friend, boss, etc.) and applied it to your life? If yes, how did it go?
  
- 4). This past year had the potential to knock us all off course. What "wins" did you find yourself chasing that really didn't guide you closer to "the win."
  
- 5.) The Apostle Paul describes the Christian life as a race. In what ways does that analogy resonate with you, and in what ways is there a disconnect?
  
- 6). Pastor Dave encouraged everyone to identify the win in the most important arenas of life (i.e. financial, spiritual, dating, marriage, parenting, etc.). After thinking about it, and maybe even discussing it with your spouse/significant other, what are the wins for you?
  
- 7). What will you need to stop doing or start doing to win? Another way to think about it is, what are the biggest distractions for you? How can this group help?

**Reflect:** What do you think God is saying to you through this passage?

**Apply:** What is one action step that I can do in light of this passage?

**Memorize:** **1 Corinthians 9:24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.**
