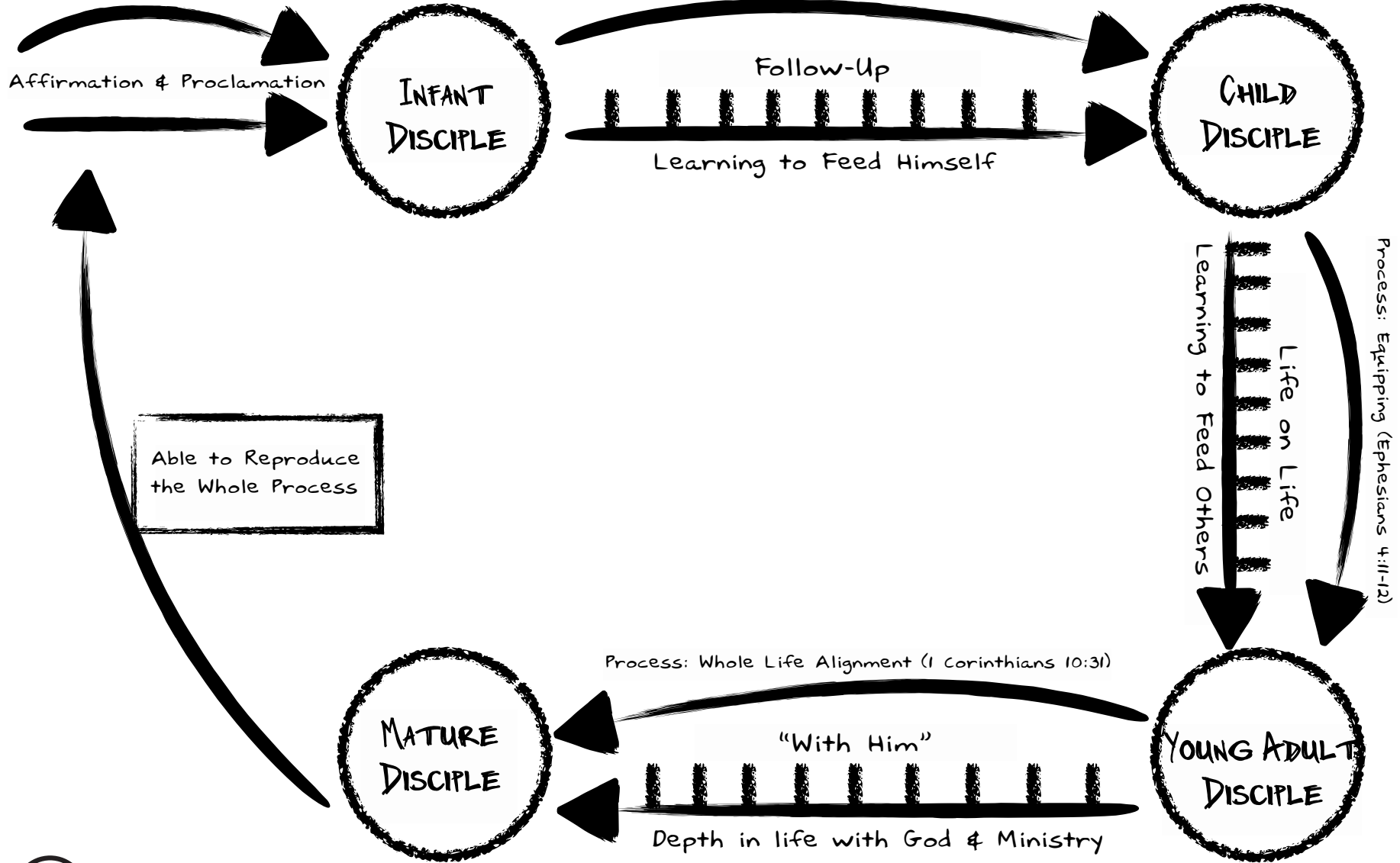

Jesus is Lord. He follows Jesus in the major areas of his life & takes steps to separate from sin. 2. Feeds herself through the Scriptures and is experienced in Quiet Times, Scripture Memory, & Bible Study. 3. Maintains a consistent devotional life that is <i>focused on application</i>. 4. Prays regularly & intentionally. 5. Involved in a faith community & demonstrates Jesus' love by serving other Christ followers. 6. Exhibits a heart for the lost. He can share his testimony & the Gospel with clarity & effectiveness. 7. Anchored in Scripture as her authority. 8. Focused on following Jesus. Continues to bear fruit of the Spirit & the fruit of a disciple. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shows the virtues and skills of a young adult disciple. 2. Exhibits heart, vision, & skill in partnering with the Holy Spirit to lead child disciples to become young adult disciples. 3. Developed awareness of strengths and shortcomings. 4. Generations of disciples are flowing from his life. 5. Demonstrates other-centered perspective & habits. 6. Others can follow her example as she follows Christ. Each facet of her life reflects the redeeming power of the Gospel.
